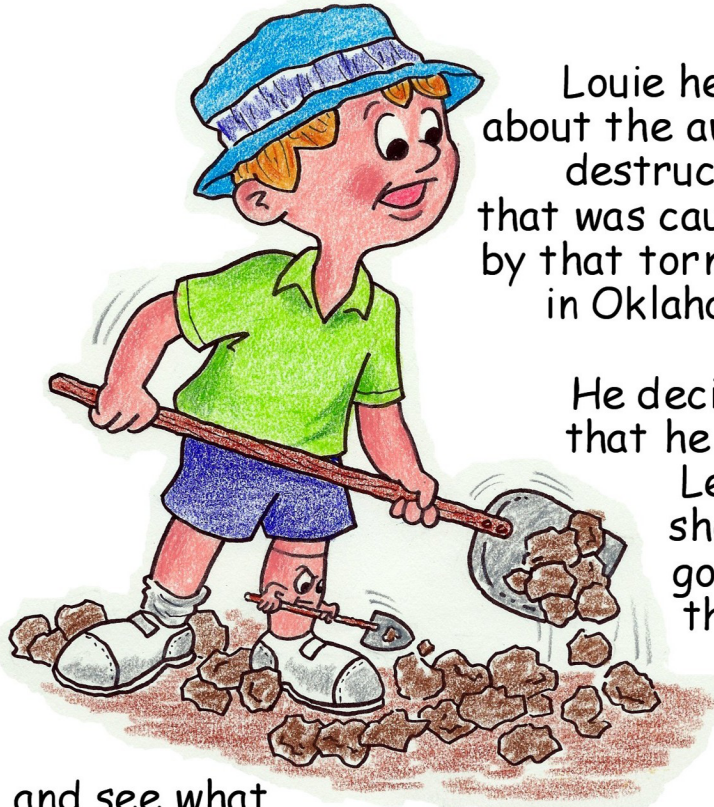


The Everyday Adventures of **LOUIE** and **LEGGO**
